

Job Description - TWH Track Captain

Why....

The objectives of the Club state that we shall cater for Road Running, Track Athletics, Cross-Country Running and other sporting events which include a running discipline.

The Track Captain will promote track events to members endeavouring to increase participation in line with our objectives.

Appointment

The Track Captain is a non-committee role appointed by the Club Committee and aligns to the Competition Secretary alongside the Road and Cross-Country Captains. The Committee reviews non committee appointments annually following the AGM.

Track Captain Job Description

The Track Captain is appointed to promote and encourage member participation at track athletic events in and around the South-East Region and nationally where applicable regardless of age.

Main responsibilities:

With the support of the Competition Secretary and the full Club Committee, the Track Captain has the responsibility to:

- report to the Competition Secretary to ensure track athletic events are promoted throughout the club similar to both road and cross-country events
- promote track competition through regular communications to all members.
- prepare and maintain a calendar highlighting known events throughout the track season.
- act as point of contact for members for all track related events/competitions excluding the club coached track sessions.
- Assist members who may be unsure on how to register for events.
- work with the club coaches to ensure track competition is promoted at the coached sessions on a Monday evening.
- promote achievement and success in any form.
